

Self-Service Instructions for Ballots for Board Elections

What you will need to create your ballot:

1. One large (#10) return envelope
2. One small (#9) envelope for your ballots
3. One statewide ballot
4. One chapter ballot
5. First-class postage (\$.55)

1. Print and fill out your statewide ballot

4. Completed your statewide and chapter ballots, put them in the small envelope and seal it.

5. Put the ballot envelope in the return envelope and seal it.

6. Print and sign your name across the sealed flap of the return envelope.

7. Affix postage and mail the return envelope:

Special instructions for Joint memberships:

Each member of a Joint membership household should print and complete their own set of ballots, and put them in a separate small ballot envelope. Both ballot envelopes may be returned in the same return envelope. Only one name and signature is needed on the return envelope.
